NSW Education Datahub

The NSW Education Datahub is a central repository of public education data in NSW. Managed by the Centre for Education Statistics and Evaluation (CESE), the Datahub aims to release data that has remained previously unpublished, whilst also presenting data from the NSW Department of Education in more accessible formats.

The Datahub currently gives users access to over 100 datasets and publications, including enrolment, attendance and assessment data. As datasets continue to be added, users can download data in a range of formats and link similar datasets for further analysis. Data published on the Datahub is presented in straightforward tables, and for certain datasets – graphs and maps.

The Datahub also seeks to engage with and be informed by the community, research sector and industry on the design of new datasets. The 'Suggest a dataset' feature allows the public to suggest useful datasets for wider release, with feedback responded to in a timely manner. If users can't find what they are looking for on the Datahub and have specialised data requests, they can contact the <u>Data Services</u> team in CESE.

Designed to be used by industry and the community, the Datahub is frequented by researchers, internal staff and other government agencies. The most widely used dataset is 'The Master Dataset for NSW Public Schools', which contains comprehensive information on all public schools in NSW.
