In this quarter (Q4 2019/20) of reporting the IPC finalised 10 (30.3%) of the 33 Regulatory Initiatives

The IPC's Regulatory Plan commenced in January 2020 and between January and March 1 (3.0%) of the total Regulatory Priorities were finalised. Accordingly, there was an increase of finalised priorities of 30.3%, with a total of 33.3% of all Regulatory Initiatives being finalised on 1 July 2020.
