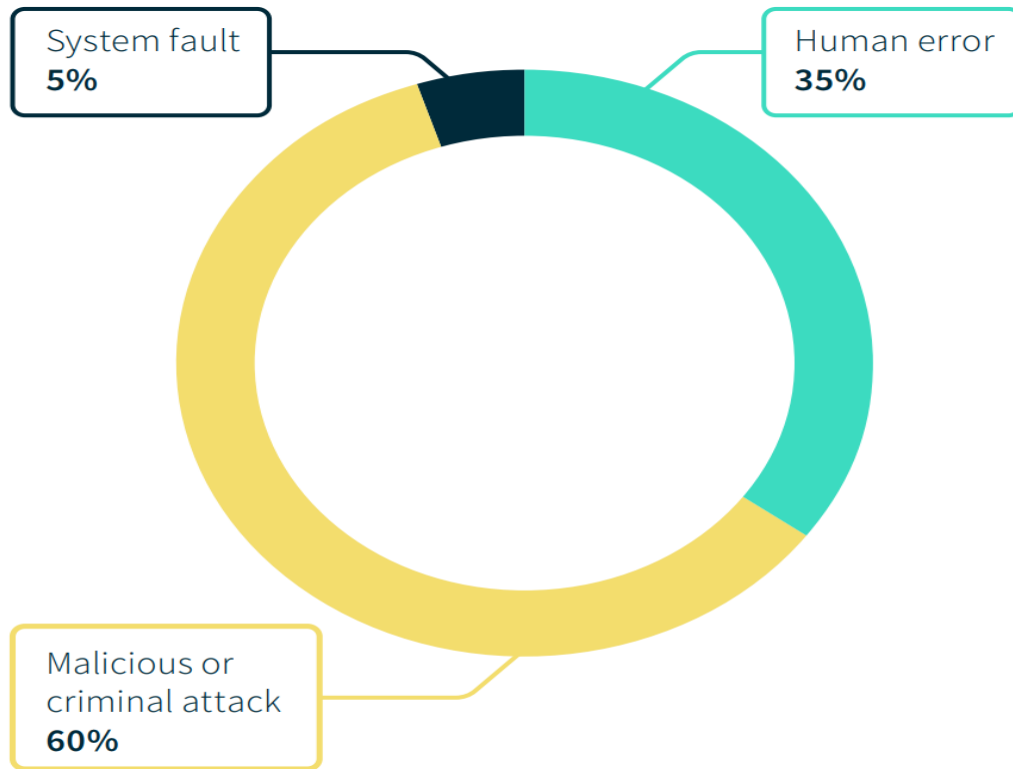


Mandatory Data Breach Notification Discussion Paper

- Consultation period extended for practitioners until 6th September
- IPC submission available on IPC website

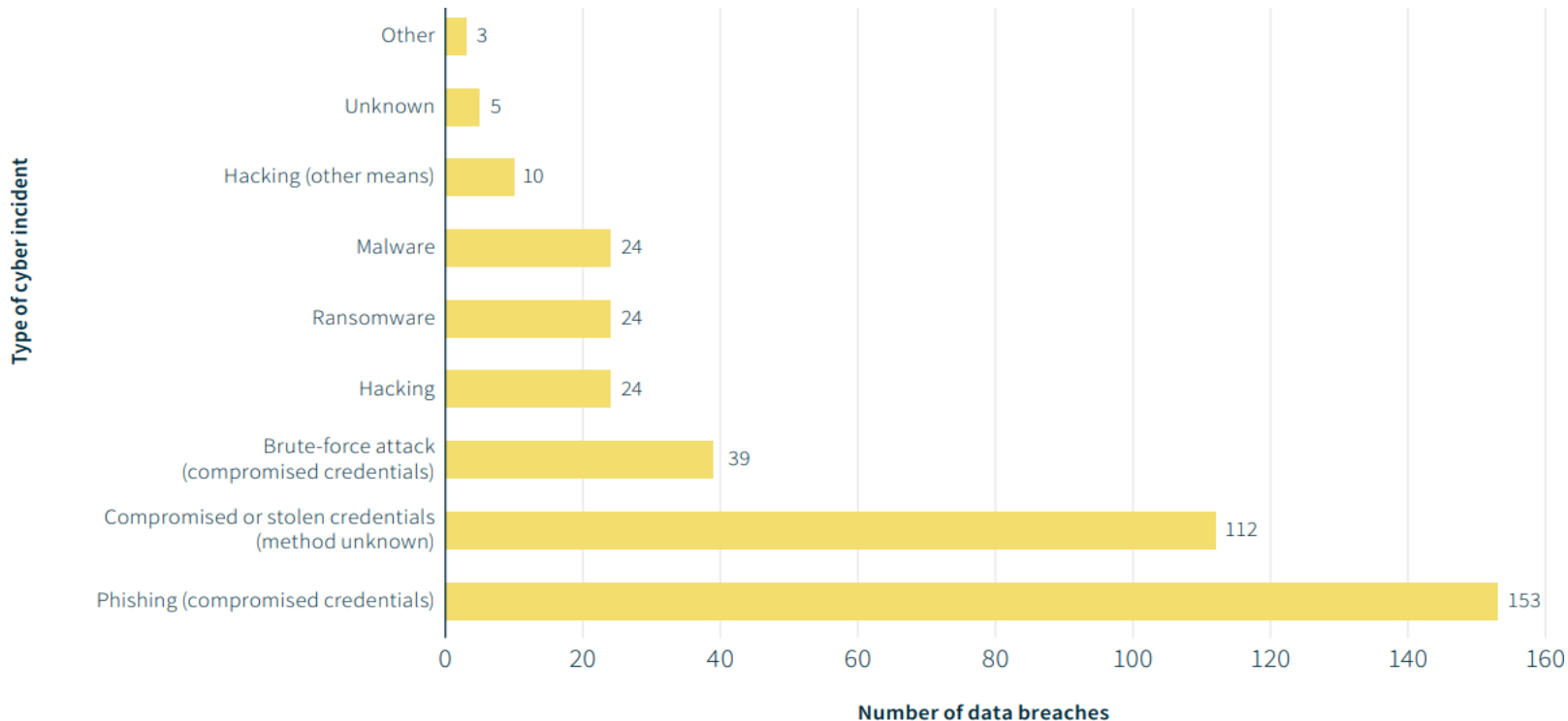
What causes data breaches?

OAIC Notifiable Data Breaches Sources 12 months Insights Report



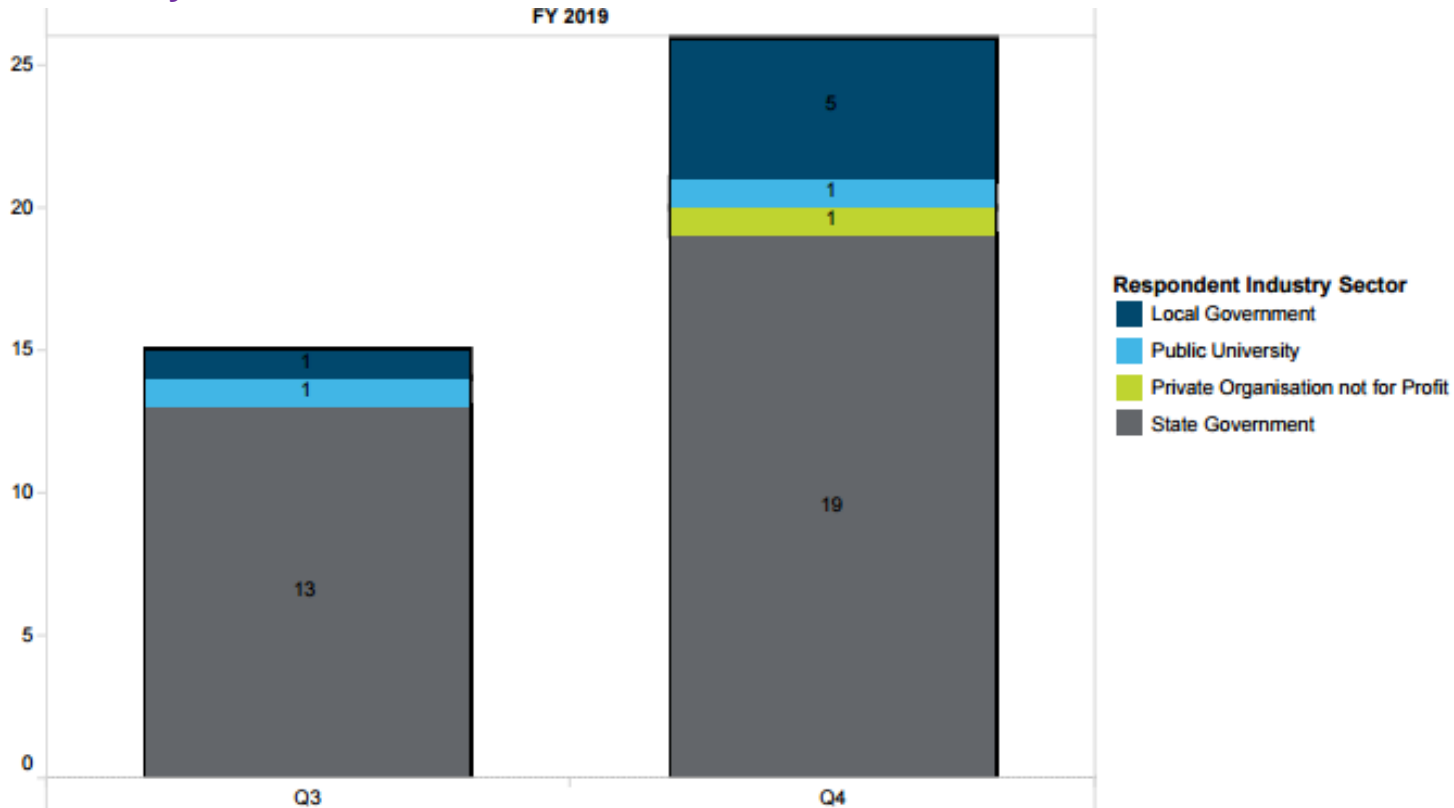
