IPC Annual Report 2018/19 highlights

2018/19 highlights include:

- Ten new privacy publications released
- Privacy Self-assessment Tool launched to assist agencies to improve their privacy governance
- Finalisation of 750 information access and privacy reviews and complaints, 28% more than in 2017/18
- 1355 privacy enquiries finalised and 200 privacy advices finalised
- 188 privacy reviews finalised and 124 privacy complaints finalised
- 74 voluntary breach notifications were made.


