IPC joint submission

Inquiry into the Public Interest Disclosures Bill 2021

- As a member of the Public Interest Disclosure Steering Committee, the Information Commissioner noted the Steering Committee's Annual Report for 2020-21 tabled in Parliament on 4 November 2021.
- The Information Commissioner welcomes the Bill, which will represent an enhancement to whistleblower protections in NSW, helping to ensure that reports of wrongdoing are acted upon, and that reporters are encouraged to come forward and are protected when they do.
- The Privacy Commissioner is to become a member of the Steering Committee and both Commissioners look forward to working to support the implementation of the new legislation, including:
 - supporting the Ombudsman's Office as it develops new public and agency guidelines, reporting tools, templates and training, and
 - providing advice to Government on the draft regulations under the Bill.

IPC case notes

Hickey v Secretary, Department of Education [2021] NSWCATAD 306

- Considers the discretion in 60(1)(a) (dealing with the application would require an unreasonable and substantial diversion of resources)
- The Tribunal applied the ss. 60(3A) and 60(3B) weighing test by designating a weight of 'little', 'moderate', or 'considerable' to each factor/evidence, similar to the s. 13 test
- The 'agency's size and resources' in s 60(3A) makes it clear that whether the agency in question is large and well-resourced will generally be relevant to the Tribunal's determination
- The 'general public interest' in favour of disclosure of government information in s. 60(3B)(a) is relevant in every case.
